

# IMPORTANT RECALL NOTICE

Please post

Attention owners of the following Cannondale bicycles and/or CODA Competition Compact Disc brakes:

These bicycles have CODA Competition Compact Disc brakes. A small population of these disc brakes has a potential problem. A screw on the back, inside surface of the caliper body may loosen and leak brake fluid. If there is a leak, fluid could contaminate the rotor and brake pads. Fluid loss could also allow the brake lever to travel too far.

**WARNING: Either possibility could cause braking loss, with risk of injury or death.**

The brake calipers are marked with date codes stamped into the rear of the lower mounting tab. Recalled brake calipers are marked 8L (1998 Dec) and 9A (1999 Jan). Calipers we have repaired have a star marking beside the date code. Repaired calipers are not subject to recall and do not require service. Both front and rear brake calipers must be checked.

Please bring your bicycle to an authorized Cannondale retailer to be checked and serviced if necessary.

These bicycles must not be ridden until they are checked and serviced as necessary.
